

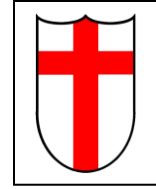

Monica Place began as a supported program of the Diocese of Huron and continues as a non denominational, not-for-profit corporation that receives some provincial funding. The current Board has representation from the Diocese and is blessed with support from churches, including their BACs, parishes and individuals from across the Diocese.

Monica Place currently has two locations to provide their residential and day-in programs to Moms and Babies, It is the only such program in our Diocese and has clients from within and beyond Huron.
