(Over 20 years) For 2 years, Lynn taught grades K-8 with local and First Nations school boards. She co-facilitated Silent Retreats for 6 years, and taught yoga for 11 years.

The Right Rev'd Robert F. Bennett

Diocesan Bishop of Huron

Incorporated Synod of the Anglican Diocese of Huron

The Right Rev'd Robert F. Bennett began ordained ministry in the Diocese of Huron in May of 1974 when he was ordained as a Deacon. A year later, he was ordained a Priest and has served parishes in: Simcoe; Woodhouse & Port Ryerse; Chesley; Tara & Paisley; Kitchener; Brantford and Windsor. Bishop Bennett has served on numerous diocesan committees including: the Pension Board; Administration & Finance; Parish Education Council; Huron Church Camp Council; as well as being appointed the Regional Dean of Brant; Archdeacon of Brant/Norfolk and later Archdeacon of Essex. Among other community organizations, he has been a member of the Board of CAS Windsor and Essex counties; the AIDs Committee of Windsor; the Windsor City Centre Revitalization Task Force; and, a member of Brantford Interfaith Counselling Centre Organization Committee. Bishop Bennett is the Chair of the Corporation of Huron University College and sits on the Board of Governors of Renison University College. He was elected as Suffragan (assistant) Bishop of Huron on June 5, 2002 and consecrated on September 14, 2002. On January 10, 2009, he was enthroned as Diocesan Bishop of Huron. Bishop Bennett has a Bachelor of Arts from the University of Western Ontario; a Master of Divinity from Huron University College; and an Honorary Doctor of Divinity.
